(Technical and professional capacity criteria and evidence), the tenderer must provide a list of the “projects of the same type (...), accompanied by statements issued by clients”. It is our understanding that “projects” refer to procurement contracts only. We base our interpretation on the fact that DG JUST has decided that statements for satisfactory execution should only be issued for procurement contracts, and not for action grants. Please confirm that our interpretation is correct.</p> <p>Question 2: According to item 3.2.2. (Technical and professional capacity criteria and evidence), the tenderer must provide a list of the “projects of the same type provided in the past three years”. It is our understanding that the “past three years” refer to the last three calendar years, i.e. starting on 1.1.2013 until the submission date. Please confirm that our interpretation is correct.</p>	<p><b>26/07/2016</b></p> <p>Answer 1: We confirm that the list of projects and related evidence specified in section "3.2.2. Technical and professional capacity criteria and evidence, A. Criteria relating to tenderers" refer to procurement contracts only.</p> <p>Answer 2: The period of "past three years" specified in section "3.2.2. Technical and professional capacity criteria and evidence, A. Criteria relating to tenderers" represents 3 years (36 months) prior to the date of submission of the offer (and not from 1.1.2013 to submission date).</p>
