3	13/05/2016 12:39	18/05/2016 13:17	Work Package 2 – B2B matchmaking	In regards with the first point of “Work Package 2 – B2B matchmaking”, is it possible to hold the “promotion event” after the B2B matchmaking in those cases where this would ensure higher participation to both? For instance, the B2B matchmaking taking place the day before the fair commences and the presentation of investment opportunities in Europe and its comparative advantages taking place during the fair in order to reach the highest number of non-European operators and potentially promote upcoming B2B matching events?	18/05/2016 “Work Package 2 – B2B matchmaking” specifies that the contractor will have to organise “an event (1/2 day) at the Fair to introduce the B2B matchmaking meetings and presenting – mainly for non-European participants – investment opportunities in Europe ...”. In other words B2B and promotion must therefore take place on the Fair premises and the promotion event must take place before the B2B meetings and with an aim to promote the latter. Activities might also take place before the official opening if the Fair offers the possibility of pre-opening events. The tenderer will then have to demonstrate why this would bring better value for money.

If so, may we know which ones?	<p>20/05/2016</p> <p>Please note that the contractor, within the context of WP1, will be asked to produce, among other things, tutorial materials and webinars that will feed the existing Tourism Business Portal and Virtual Tourism Observatory. These portals are owned by the Commission, targeting mainly European undertakings/operators and are currently developed only in English. Therefore the contractor will be asked to create the above said content in English.</p> <p>The contractor will also be asked to promote the B2B events. Footnote 16 states that: "The promotion of this Action and B2B events should be done via websites, networks, social media, web bannering and other communication tools in all the Member States in order to ensure a balanced geographical representation. Existing EU platforms like Enterprise Europe Network, ELAN -Europe-Latin America Business Network-, EBOs and Asia Coordination Platform must also be exploited for diffusion of this information".</p> <p>Therefore, it is up to the tenderer to identify the most effective communication tools and - taking into consideration the communication</p>

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					<p>consideration the communication tools and channels selected and the target of the communication activity – propose the language regime for the advertising.</p> <p>It is important to note that the specifications do not require to set up an online website/portal. However, this could be possible if the tenderer considers that it is useful for the project implementation. It is the onus of the tenderer to justify its decision and demonstrate its added value.</p>

Interpretation costs can therefore be covered by this service contract. It remains a choice of the tenderer if to provide or not interpretation and in which languages. The tenderer must justify in its bid the choice made and demonstrate that it is the most effective / most efficient organisational solution.

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6	13/05/2016 17:16	20/05/2016 16:27	Language criteria	- Regarding the B3 criteria for language quality check (page 25 of technical specifications), we understand the assigned team needs to have at least 2 members with B2 level skills in all languages of the international target markets. However, we would just like to clarify if it is necessary to have at least 2 team members speaking each language, or if we can have, for instance, 3 team members that in total have B2 language skills in all 5 languages.	20/05/2016 The call states that at least 2 members of the team should have "at least B2 level in the Common European Framework for Reference for Languages in the languages of the international target markets". This should be understood as: "for each language spoken in the 5 target markets there should be in the team at least 2 members having a B2 level knowledge of that language". There could therefore be 2 or more persons in the team satisfying this criterion because theoretically 1 member of the team may have a B2 level knowledge of all languages spoken in the 5 target markets.

Please specify what are the countries eligible for participation in this tender.	20/05/2016 Pursuant to Article 119(1) of the Financial Regulation "Participation in procurement procedures shall be open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons coming within the scope of the Treaties and to all natural and legal persons established in a third country which has a special agreement with the Union in the field of public procurement under the conditions laid down in that agreement."
