Our question is: 1. We understand that if a subcontractor's share of the contract is less than 10%, but the subcontractor's capacity is indeed needed to fulfil the selection criteria, then we would not need to submit a Declaration on Honour nor any supporting documents. Can you confirm this understanding is correct?
