Do we have to understand that the contractors must have access beforehand and be authorised to access it as of now? Or, that the EDA will provide access in a timely fashion to the three best ranked tenderers and the declaration has to be provided as evidence for the following service contracts?</p>	<p>20/08/2019 Tenderers must have access to EDA's 3 prioritisation tools before submitting a tender in order to prove their capacity (technical & professional capacity, criterion 2.3) to carry out the work subject to this call for tenders. A tenderer is considered having access when meeting the criteria described in par. 1.1 ("...industries established in the 27 EDA participating Member States that do not have limitations in terms of intellectual property rights, security of supply, security of information or export controls stemming from entities outside the 27 EDA participating Member States.").</p> <p>19/09/2019 Complementarily to the answer provided on 20/08/2019 in relation to security of information and as per the tendering specifications and the contractual terms and conditions, all information communicated, handled, generated, exchanged between the European Defence Agency and the contractor in the frame of the Framework Contract is to be handled confidentially. The contractor is to ensure that all necessary means are taken to guarantee that none of the above referred information is communicated, in one way or another, directly and/or indirectly to entities established outside the territory of any</p>

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					established outside the territory of any of the 27 EDA PMS. The European Defence Agency is entitled to require evidence of such above referred means before the awarding of the FWC and any time throughout the execution of tasks encompassed in frame of the FWC. Failure to respect such confidentiality requirements will amount to a contractual material breach.

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
