To take an example, if 2 projects of more than 100k€ are part of the references submitted and cover some of the fields identified, shall experience in an additional field (not covered by the first 2 projects) be justified by a reference with a value lower than 100k€ ?	08/09/2020 For the purposes of the evidence A1 in section 4.2.4, the tenderer must provide references for at least two projects delivered in the last three years, each covering one or more of the fields mentioned with a minimum value for each project of € 100 000. As this is a minimum requirement, the tenderer may submit additional references covering the other fields mentioned of whatever value, and not included in the first two references, as long as the minimum requirement is fulfilled.

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
