It is also open to all natural and legal persons established in a third country which has a special agreement with the European Union in the field of public procurement on the conditions laid down in that agreement (namely, under the Stabilisation and Association Agreements (SAA) economic operators established in North Macedonia, Albania, Montenegro, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Kosovo have been granted access to procurement procedures of EASO regardless of the value of the purchase. Moreover, under the European Economic Agreement, economic operators established in Iceland, Norway and Liechtenstein have full access to procurement procedures of EASO). Being launched by an EU Agency, this procurement procedure is NOT open to the countries parties to the Agreement on Government Procurement, except for Iceland,
